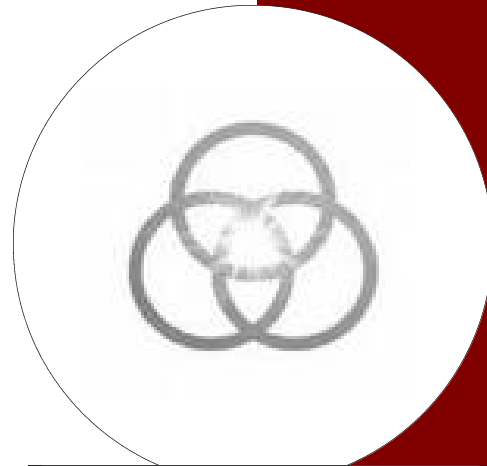

# TRINITY

*The LORD our God is one LORD*

## TRINITY: *Tri* meaning three; *Unity* meaning one Tri + Unity = Trinity

Scripture gives us a picture, an expression, of the triune essence of God. Although there are countless Scriptures that address only the Father, or only Jesus Christ, or only the Holy Spirit, there are a multitude of Scriptures that show the cohesiveness and the oneness of Their power, Their character and Their work.

Scripture teaches us that there is only one God, and He exists as one essence in three distinct Persons. All three Persons are called God and are God. The three Persons of God are perfectly united in relationship to one another:

“And God said, Let Us make man in Our image, after Our likeness...” Gen. 1:26a

“And the Lord God said, Behold, the man is become as one of Us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:” Gen. 3:22

“Go to, let Us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another’s speech.” Gen. 11:7

“Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.” Is. 6:8

The Bible clearly shows that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons. The three Persons are God the Father, God the Son (Jesus Christ), and God the

Holy Spirit. The Persons are distinct. The Father is not the Son. The Son is not the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is not the Father.

### There is only one God:

“Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD.” Deut. 6:4

“I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside Me.” Is. 45:5

### The Father is God:

“But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by Him.” 1 Cor. 8:6 (also Eph. 4:4-6)

### The Son is God:

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth”. John 1:1,14

“I and the Father are one.” John 10:30

Also Heb. 1:6-8 and Phil 2:9-11

### The Holy Spirit is God:

“But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled

thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost?... Thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.” Acts 5:3-4

“Now the Lord is that Spirit.” 2 Cor. 3:17

### Many Bible passages mention the three Persons together:

“And Jesus, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him [John], and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him: And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” Matt. 3:16-17

“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:” Matt. 28:19

“For He whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto Him. The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into His hand.” John 3:34-35

“But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.” John 14:26

“Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as My Father hath sent Me, even so send I you. And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:” John 20:21-22

“Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God, which He had promised afore by His prophets in the holy Scriptures, concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.” Rom. 1:1-4

“Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope: And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.” Rom. 5:1-5

“But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth His Son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.” Gal. 4:4

“For through Him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father. Eph. 2:18

“For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner

man.” Eph. 3:14-17

“There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.” Eph. 4:4-6

“And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.” 1 Cor. 6:11

“Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.” 1 Cor. 12:4-6

“Now He which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is God; Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.” 2 Cor. 1:21-22

“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all.” 2 Cor. 13:14

“But after that the kindness and love of God our Savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, but the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; when He showed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior...” Tit. 3:4-6

“Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father; Knowing,

brethren beloved, your election of God. For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost...” 1 Thes. 1:3-5a

“How shall we escape, if we neglect so great a salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard Him; God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to His own will?” Heb. 2:3-4

“Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.” 1 Pet. 1:2

“For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:” 1 Pet. 3:18

“For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.” 1 John 5:7

“But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.” Jude 1:20-21
